

Reporting Crimes and Other Emergencies

Central Arizona College encourages students, employees and others to report all criminal action and emergencies as soon as possible:

To report a crime or emergency on the Signal Peak Campus, the caller should contact the College Police Department at 836-9655.

To report a crime or emergency occurring at any of the other CAC satellite campuses or centers, the caller should contact the local emergency operator by dialing 911.

As soon as possible thereafter, the caller should contact the College Police Department. Reports of a non-emergency nature, regardless of campus location, should be made to the Police Department at 520-836-9655.

When reporting a crime or an emergency, try to call from a safe location. Remain calm and be prepared to answer the following questions:

The location of the emergency, including the campus address and the exact location of the incident on campus.

The nature of the emergency (fire, medical, hazardous material, etc.).

How many people are injured and the extent of their injuries?

How did it happen?

When did it happen?

- Your name and telephone number. Do not hang up until instructed to do so by the dispatcher.
