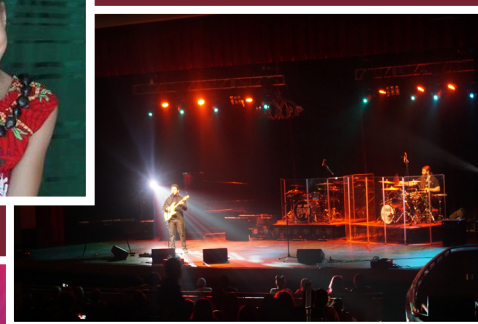
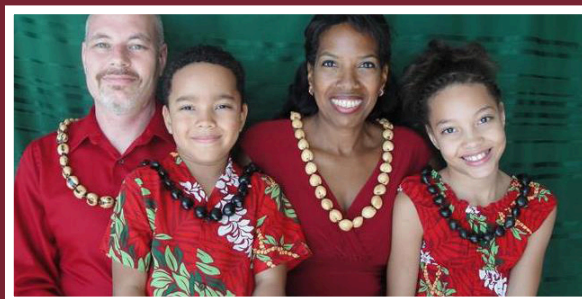

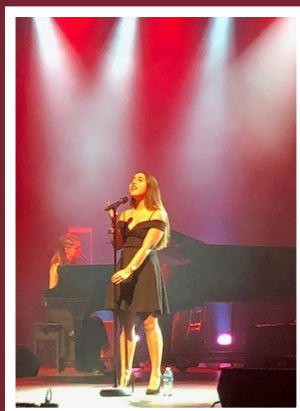
CAC Choir, Handbell Choir

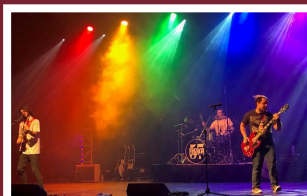

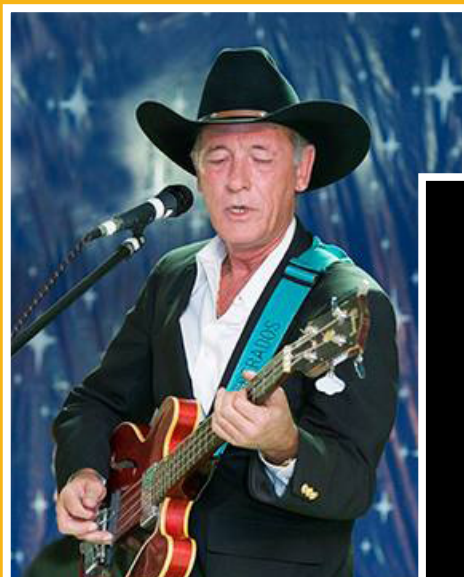
New Christy Minstrels (Folk)

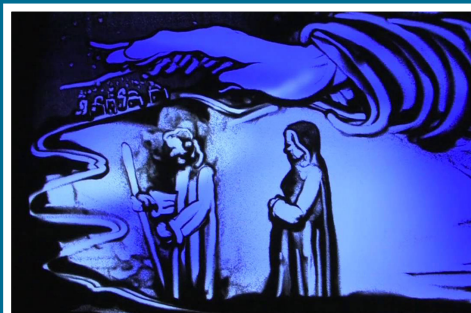

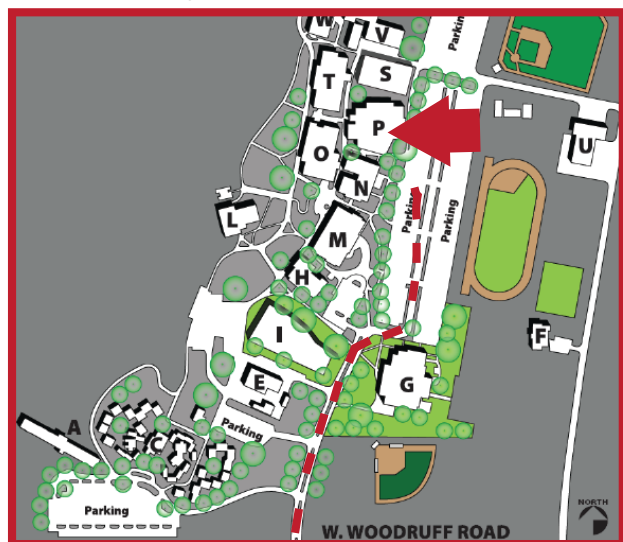

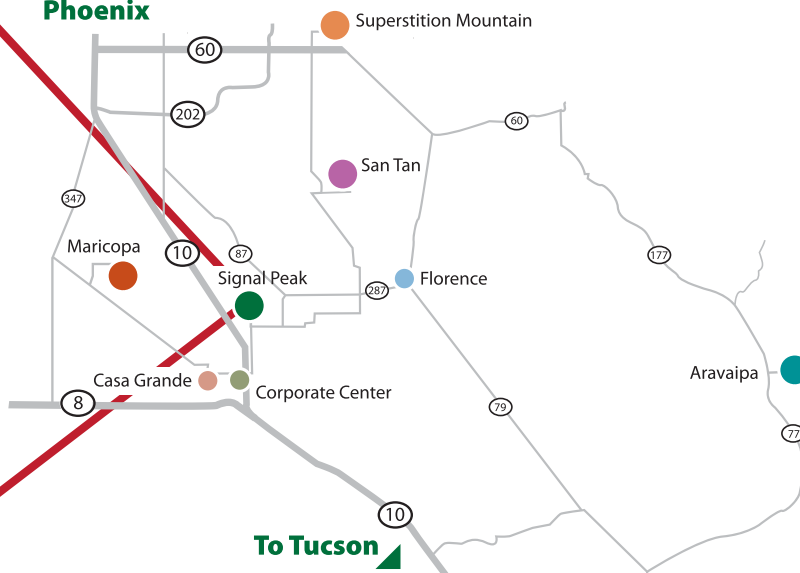
