### Program Description

The Plumbing Certificate Level II program at Central Arizona College is designed for individuals who have completed introductory plumbing training and are ready to advance their skills in residential, commercial, and industrial plumbing systems. This program follows the nationally recognized NCCER Plumbing Level II, level III, and level IV curriculum, ensuring students gain industry-aligned competencies and hands-on experience. Students will expand their knowledge in areas such as: Plumbing code requirements, Pipefitting techniques for various materials, plumbing system installation and testing, Blueprint reading, Advanced fixtures and appliances, Water distribution and drain-waste-vent (DWV) systems. Instruction combines classroom learning with lab-based, hands-on training. Students will also continue logging hours toward NCCER certification and may qualify for advanced placement in registered apprenticeship programs or direct workforce entry in plumbing and pipefitting roles.
