Program Description: The Practical Nursing (PN) Certificate program in practical nursing provides an option for wishing to gain licensure as a practical nurse or for the AAS Nursing student who wishes to exit the RN program and gain employment as a Practical Nurse. Upon successful completion of the PN program requirements, the graduate receives a certificate of proficiency and is eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nursing (NCLEX-PN). When the graduate passes the NCLEX-PN, they will be eligible to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) in the state of Arizona.

HESI Nursing entrance exam at CAC prior to submitting application. The HESI must be completed within three attempts with the following scores: 80% minimum with 90-95% preferred on Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Vocabulary, and

Mathematics and 70% minimum on Anatomy/Physiology. (A 30 day wait is required before retesting.) Cumulative **GPA of 2.75** or higher on nursing prerequisite/corequisite.
