	Completed <b>BIO202 Anatomy &amp; Physiology II</b> with a grade of "C" or better (within 5 years prior to the application.)
	Licensed Nursing Assistant ( <b>LNA</b> ) or Licensed Practical Nurse ( <b>LPN</b> )- <b>CNA125</b> : Nursing Assistant course is offered at CAC or other AZ Board of Nursing Approved Licensed Nursing Assistant programs can be found at: <a href="https://www.azbn.gov/education/nursing-programs-lists">https://www.azbn.gov/education/nursing-programs-lists</a>

The HESI must be completed within three attempts with the following scores: 80% minimum with 90-95% preferred on <b>Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Vocabulary, and Mathematics</b> and 70% minimum on Anatomy/Physiology. (A 30-day wait is required before retesting.)
	Cumulative <b>GPA of 2.75</b> or higher on nursing prerequisite/corequisite.
