Steps to Enrollment

- Step 1: Admission:** Fill out the entire Student Information Form at any location, or at www.centralaz.edu. A student ID number/card is required for all transactions at Central Arizona College. There is no charge for the first ID; there is a replacement fee of \$10.
- Step 2: Orientation:** The College requires completion of assessment (placement testing) in the areas of writing, reading, and mathematics prior to meeting with an advisor and registering. Assessment is used to place students in English, math, and other courses based on test scores which have identified minimum skill levels. Orientation is required for new students in order to become acquainted with the nature, purpose, services, activities and resources of the College. Please contact a campus near you to register for an orientation or register online at www.centralaz.edu/orientation.
- Step 3: Advisement:** All students pursuing a degree or certificate or enrolling in a course with a prerequisite, must meet with an advisor prior to registration. If you have attended a prior college, bring copies of your transcripts to your advising session.
- Step 4: Registration:** Students must complete an official registration form in order to be officially enrolled in classes. Registration dates are published each year in the Academic Calendar. Learning starts day one, students are only permitted to enroll in a class that has not already met. Changes in a student's schedule, such as dropping or adding classes, may be accomplished on-line at www.centralaz.edu or in person. Phone requests regarding registration are not permitted.
- Step 5: On-Campus Housing:** (available only at the Signal Peak Campus.) Complete a housing application, pay the \$150 deposit and provide proof of immunizations to the Residence Life Office or at 520-494-5470. Students interested in on-campus housing must apply early for a guaranteed assignment.
- Step 6: Fee Payment:** Payment of all tuition and fees is **required at the time of registration**. Students will be withdrawn from courses for non-payment according to the scheduled dates. Payment may be made in person, by mail, or by eCheck and credit card online at www.centralaz.edu. It is the responsibility of the student to be aware of the tuition refund/withdrawal policy.

- * Students will be assigned a unique student identification number. Students should be aware that a correct Social Security number must be on file for reporting information pertaining to potential tax credits and must be used by applicants for federal and state aid.
