A Presentation on Guided Pathways was presented to the Board. The Guided Pathways reform has become a national movement in community colleges. As of Spring 2018, more than 250 community colleges have committed to undertaking large scale guided pathways reforms as part of national, state or regional efforts. For successful Guided Pathways institutions, on average, retention rates rose by 12% and completion rates by 18%.
