

College ACCUPLACER Course Placement and Transfer Score Conversion

Placement Testing evaluates a student's skill and ability in Reading Comprehension, Writing, and Mathematics. The goal of these assessments is to place students in the appropriate level of coursework. Test scores aid the student and their advisor in developing a progressive academic and career plan. Many of the classes offered to degree seeking students require a reading proficiency prerequisite. Central Arizona College requires that students demonstrate reading skills and comprehension at a 12th Grade Level. The placement test will assess the student's appropriate level of reading skill and comprehension. Completing the reading course(s) will increase a student's overall academic success.
