

2020-2021 Dependent Verification Worksheet Federal Student Aid

Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is selected for a review process called "Verification." This process is used to verify certain information on the FAFSA to ensure its accuracy. The federal government requires colleges and universities to verify or confirm the data reported on the FAFSA application before awarding Federal Student Aid. Documents requested will be compared with your application; any discrepancies found will be corrected and reported back to FAFSA.

What you should do: Do not leave any sections blank, any blank sections will be valued at zero.

- 1. Complete and sign the worksheet. Signature of parent used to complete FAFSA.
- 2. Collect you and your parents' financial documents (2018 federal tax return transcripts).
- 3. Talk to your financial aid office if you have questions about completing this worksheet.
- 4. Upload completed worksheet along with tax return transcripts and any other documents through your CAC Student Portal.
