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Program Description: The Nutrition & Foodservice Professional (NFP) Training Program Certificate prepares food service workers and/or supervisors for management roles in health care facilities and various other foodservice establishments. This certificate has been approved by the Association of Nutrition and Foodservice Professionals (ANFP) as a successful pathway (ANFP Pathway I) to obtain the nationally recognized credential Certified Dietary Manager, Certified Foodservice Protection Professional (CDM, CFPP). Upon completion of the certificate, students are eligible to sit for the National Certified Dietary Manager Exam.

Use this Program Map as a guide to choose courses with your advisor and track progress toward milestones and completion of program. Work with an advisor to customize your plan to align with your specific career and/or transfer goals.

Recommended Proficiencies: High School diploma or GED

Individuals that have two years of institution foodservice management experience, may qualify to be part of the Certified Dietary Manager, Certified Food Protection Professional Certificate Program or CDM Fast Track (Pathway III(b)) at CAC. CAREER INFORMATION

CDM, CFPPs are nationally recognized experts at managing foodservice operations. Many work in healthcare, nursing facilities, rehabilitation facilities, senior living communities, or hospitals. Some work in correctional facilities, schools, and the military, others work for corporations. The salary for a CDM ranges from \$48,600 to \$68,000.

National Certification (Credentialing Exam)

Students who complete the certificate are eligible to earn two credentials, Certified Dietary Manager (CDM) and Certified Food Protection Professional (CFPP) by taking a National Certification Exam offered by Association of Nutrition & Foodservice Professionals (ANFP).
