**SEMESTER 1 (or before): 0-15 credits (Freshman)**

**SEMESTER 2: 16-30 credits (Freshman)**

**SEMESTER 3: 30-45 credits (Sophomore)**

- Apply to University AND College Degree Program (*as early as 1 year before your start date*)
- Calculate the Cost and Plan Housing
- Research/Apply to University Scholarships/Grants
- Complete FASFA on October 1st: Choose University you will be transferring into

**SEMESTER 4: 46-64 credits (Sophomore)**
